Since the start of the program, 839 students have applied with 560 students having completed the program. Our students come from 57 universities located across the US. The intensive 6 week course is held in Clovis, NM, which is located in the 3rd largest US milk shed, eastern New Mexico and the Texas panhandle. This location allows us to have access to modern dairy facilities and milking systems, which include robotics facilities as well as other precision management programs, which are becoming more relevant in modern dairy herd management. Major subjects that are covered include; reproduction, nutrition, genetics, young stock, transition cow, mastitis and machine management, heat abatement and facilities. Our faculty comes from across the US and are experts in their respective fields. The program is completely funded through agribusiness support. Through their generous sponsorships, students are able to attend the consortium at virtually no expensive. The consortium also counts toward a students degree plan at some universities. The success of the consortium lies in the fact that over 60% of our graduates have entered in the dairy/agribusiness profession.
